

# Blue Ridge Landfill Facility Rules

---

The following rules and procedures must be followed by all vehicles that enter the Blue Ridge Landfill. These rules are in place to provide a safe and efficient environment for our employees and our customers.

- Only the driver is allowed to exit the vehicle during unloading operations at the working face. **Every person is required to wear PPE** (hard hat, safety vest, safety glasses, gloves, and safety boots).
- No minors allowed outside the vehicle.
- All vehicles transporting materials to the Landfill are subject to vehicle inspection and weigh check.
- All loads entering the Landfill **must be completely and securely covered** / all openings secured to prevent the escape of any material. No debris on top, sides or either end of the vehicle (uncovered load will be assessed a fee).
- All coverings shall remain in place and secure until at the unloading areas. Loads covered with a tarp will be asked to remove tarp(s) on the scales for inspection.
- Please obey all traffic signs.
- All traffic shall weigh in at the scale complex. Your vehicle will be scanned by radiation detectors. If anything is detected please **follow the direction of site personnel**.
- Drivers must unload at spots identified by working face personnel, follow the posted separation distances between trucks when backing into your spot.
- If directed to unload in a separate area for random load inspection, do not leave the inspection area until directed to do so by the site personnel.
- Any unacceptable waste will be reloaded into the vehicle and removed from the Landfill.
- Do not leave the unloading area until visually confirming the vehicle is completely empty, doors closed, secured and covered.
- Smoking allowed in designated areas only.
